## How to Turn Off Find My iPhone From a Computer

- 1. **POWER OFF** your device.
  - You can either wait and let the battery run out or attempt to use Siri by saying "Hey Siri, shut down" and then "yes" to confirm.
- 2. Log into your <u>www.icloud.com</u> account.
- 3. If you have Two-Factor Authentication enabled, you are still able to access this by going to "Find Devices"
