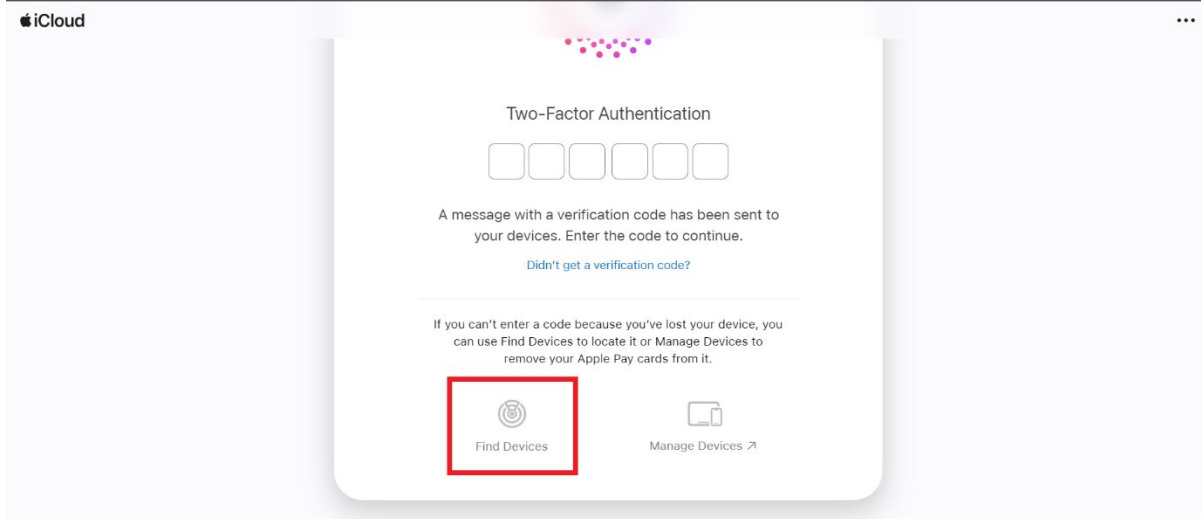
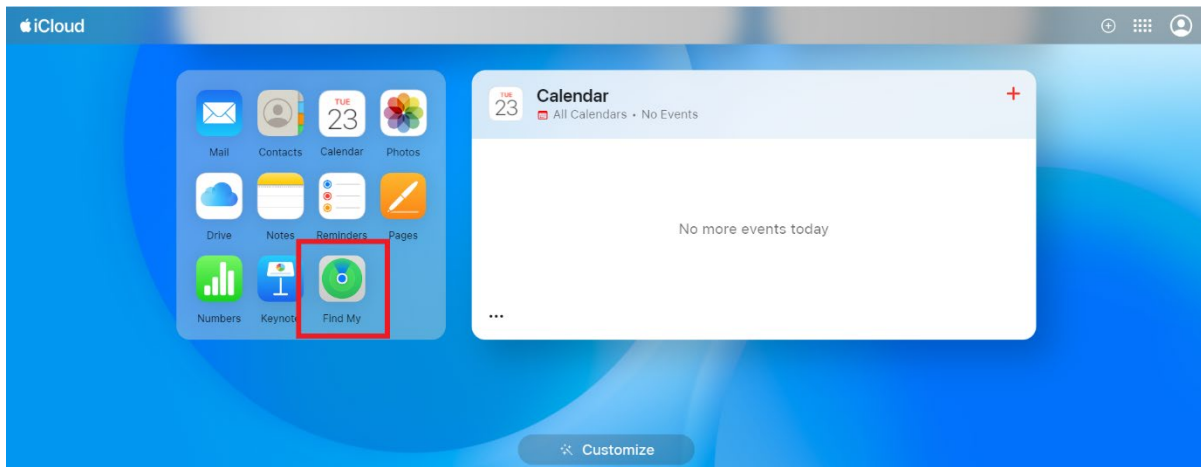


How to Turn Off Find My iPhone From a Computer

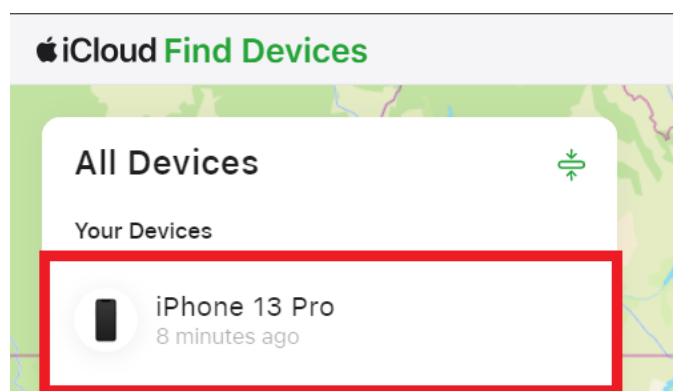
1. **POWER OFF** your device.
 - You can either wait and let the battery run out or attempt to use Siri by saying “Hey Siri, shut down” and then “yes” to confirm.
2. Log into your www.icloud.com account.
3. If you have Two-Factor Authentication enabled, you are still able to access this by going to “Find Devices”



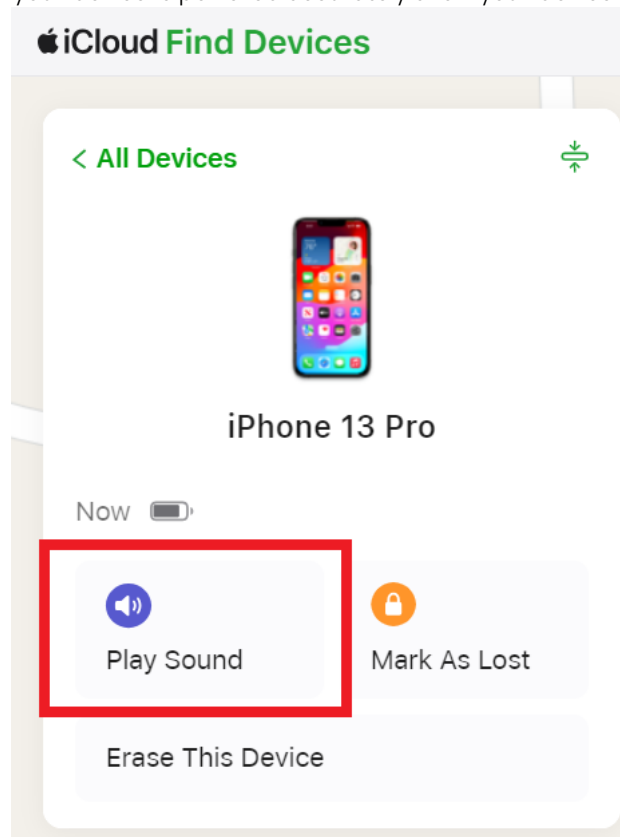
4. If you do **not** have Two-Factor Authentication enabled, scroll down to find the “Find My” icon.



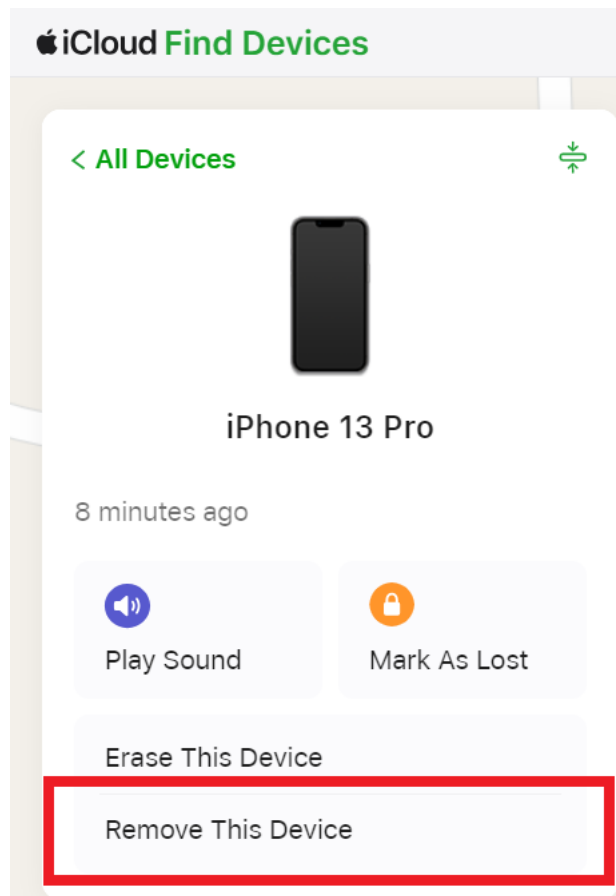
5. Select your device on the left-hand side of the page.



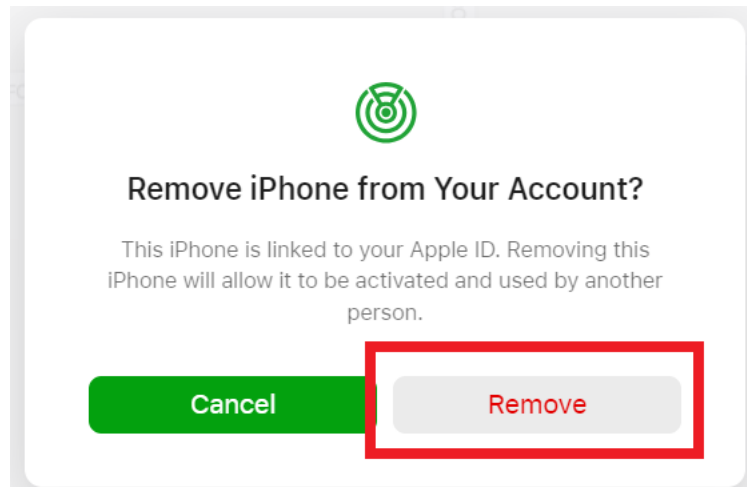
6. If your only option is to “Erase this Device” then press the “Play Sound” so Find My updates to accurately show your device is powered accurately show your device is **POWERED OFF**.



7. After a few seconds you should see “Remove This Device”. Click this.



8. You will see a notification confirming you wish to remove the iPhone from Your Account. Click "Remove"



9. You will be prompted for your password once again. Enter your password and hit "Remove".
